## **JEREMY CORBYN** **BIOGRAPHY**

Jeremy was first elected to parliament in 1983.

He would prefer that the cost of replacing Trident nuclear missiles go toward basic needs such as health and housing, and he has voted against the Iraq and Afghanistan wars.

In the last five years Jeremy has tabled 709 parliamentary questions, and made 878 parliamentary speeches of one sort or another on a wide range of subjects.

He has held many roles including Vice Chair of the All Party Human Rights Group (APPG)

Chair of the Chagos APPG as well as the Parliamentary CND Group, and membership of the newly established London Select Committee, and of many other APPGs.

Before entering Parliament, Jeremy was a full time official for NUPE (now part of Unison);

He remains a member of, and supported by, Unison in Parliament.
