Entered Parliament in 1997 as MP for Blackpool South.

Gordon is President of the British Resorts and Destinations Association and chair of a Seaside Towns Manifesto Group.

He's campaigned ceaselessly in Parliament to highlight the particular needs and priorities of Blackpool and other seaside towns.

Gordon has been a member of Parliament's Innovation, Universities & Skills Select Committee - helping develop policy on citizenship and young people, skills, further education, and special educational needs.

He is also Chair of the All Party-Parliamentary Skills Group and he is passionate about tackling the adult skills gap and re-skilling older workers.
