Lisa is the PPS to Tessa Jowell MP, Shadow Olympics Minister and a member of the Education Select Committee. Lisa also chairs the All Party Parliamentary Group on International Corporate Responsibility. Before entering Parliament she worked for a national children's charity (The Children's Society). Lisa graduated from Newcastle Univ. in 2001 & later earned a Masters degree from the Univ of London, studying as a mature student. She went on to work as a researcher and caseworker for Labour MP Neil Gerrard. She worked at the youth homeless charity Centrepont where Lisa helped to push through changes so that no 16/17 year old could any longer be placed into unsafe B&B accommodation.

Lisa is a member of the UNITE union and has been a grassroots activist in the union movement ever since her first job in a call centre. Lisa is a regular columnist for Tribune, Labour List and Children and Young People Now Magazine. She is a regular panellist on Radio 4's 'Westminster Hour' and 5 Live's 'Pienaar's Politics'. She is conducting a cross-party inquiry into the education of looked after children with Edward Timpson MP and also recently introduced a bill to ensure the UK underwrites ethical business practices overseas and provides more support to small businesses.
