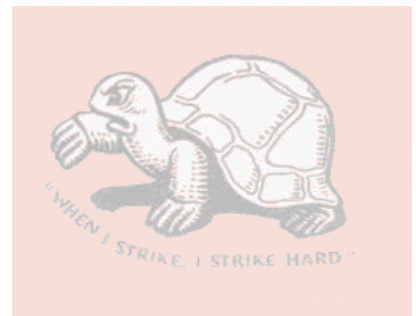

Alan was born in 1950 & educated at Isleworth Grammar School and gained a BA and PhD at Southampton University.

He subsequently held posts as a director of two national research charities and was leader of Southampton City Council 1984-92. After leaving the council he became Professor of Public Policy at Southampton Institute.

He was elected to Parliament in 1997 for Southampton Test & between June 2001- May 2002 was Parliamentary Under Secretary of State in the Department for Transport, Local Government and the Regions.

He is currently Chair of the Associate Parliamentary Renewable and Sustainable Energy Group ; Co-Chair, Associate Parliamentary Sustainable Resources Group; and Chair of the All-Party Parliamentary Group on Poland.

He is also a member of the Parl. Justice Committee and Standards & Privileges Select Committee and the new Energy and Climate Change Select Committee.

He currently heads the Prime Minister's Manifesto Group on Local Government.

Married with one son and one daughter, his interests include football, writing and tennis.
